By Organisational own Resources: THE NGO HAS ORGANISED MANY TYPES OF WELFARE & OTHER PROGRAMMES ONE DAY EACH AS FOLLOWS:

1. **PROMGRAMME ON WOMEN RIGHTS :-** The Society has organized programs on women right at district. In this programme was attended by a member or women participants. The NGO's and the member of Society told about the fundamental rights of the women and also to educate all the women in rural and urban areas to stand face a problem which always happens in their life's in the time to come.
2. **S.C., S.T., OBC's AWARENESS PROGRAMME:-** Despite of passing of so many years after the independence-Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Minorities have not yet been associated in the main stream of the Society. They still need a lot of support not only from the Government but it also from the Society and NGOs. Understand its responsibility the society has organized a number of progresses targeted at the welfare of the SC/ST/OBCs. This includes imparting non-tonal education in the areas of SC/ST/OBCs, providing them technical and financial help in setting up their own business and pursuing higher studies.
3. **DRUG DE-ADDICATION AWARENESS PROGRAMME :-** The Society has been conducting camps aimed at raising awareness about the bad effects of the alcoholism and drinking. The volunteers of the Society went into the villages to raise consciousness about the effects of smoking and drinking and use of tobacco. Apart from this the persons who have given up the habit of drinking encouraged people to follow their path and the restraint that the one needs to take to give up this habit. It was started that thousands of people die every year because of the use of tobacco and other like thing.
4. **CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAMME :-** Consumer Awareness programme were organized to make public aware of the rights available under the Consumer Protection Act, 1986. The Programmers were appreciated by the Attendants. It is generally found that the consumers, despite of playing low prices are offered low quality by the Companies. Though the products are packed in very attractive packages but, their quality happens to be very low. This way consumer gets cheated every day by the producers and sellers. This situation is not too different in the cases of series also. Under the consumer Protection Act, 1986, the Rules and producers for filling the suit way and manner of filling the appeals. Further they were given names and addresses of different consumer associates whom they can contact in cases of need.
5. **AIDS & CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAMME :-** No disease has ever ended the life. The way aids does. HIV has become the biggest challenge before the mankind as because it is an infectious disease. The danger that it poses is immense. The only way, to escape AIDS to be aware of all the ways in which AIDS can take place. A programme was organised by the society at village to educate the time of taking injections & blood test etc. to remain safe from cancer.
6. **WOMEN CHILD HEALTH PROGRAMME :-** An awareness generation programmes timed at making women aware about their health needs and nutrition was organized by the society. The programmes was organized by the rural women in large number and it was felt by the attendants that kind of programmers was organized are very useful in the villages where women were awareness about their health need at a very low cost. Further they informed about various kinds of scheme formed and executed. The women particularly in the programme were informed about need for education and agreed to send their children particularly the girl child to school. Further it was resolved that the society will further organize similar programmes in the near future.

7. WATER CONSERVATION, SANITATION & HYGIENE AWARENESS PROGRAMME:- Drinking water, sanitation & hygiene awareness programme was organized by the society. The main aim of the society is to provide pure and clear water. So, the villagers were told how the wells, tube wells & ponds were to be cleared and to take support if they feel need of the members of the society. The members of the society aware the public about water, which they use and society also has been very active in the field of raising awareness about good sanitation facilities in the slum area. Lack of good sanitation is curse of the majority of the urban population. Disproportionately, increasing Population has made situation much worse. All the efforts made by the civic come forward and help the civic authorities in providing sanitation facilities to more and more people.

8. EXPS. ON SHORT STAY HOME & FAMILY COUNSELLING CENTRE:- To the help of women the NGO society established a short stay home & family counselling centre in Ramgarh block of Dumka district to settle the needy women on temporary basis and tries to help them solving their problems that they become able to be settled in their family again among the children & financially supported many of them to a great extent.

9. CHILD/HEALTH LABOUR AWARENESS PROGRAMME :- A Programme on Women & Child Labour was organised by the society on Labour-day. In this Programme the volunteers aware the public about women/child labour and told them about the Labour Act to the participants.

10. AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS :- The society has taken a number of steps for the support of the handicapped and it has plan to school for the handicapped. Other measures taken by the society includes raising society about the handicapped so that they do not get separated in the society. Apart from this the society and the volunteers told to the villagers to explore their talent in the village. The NGO is planning to establish a school for benefit to the disabled people.

11. FAMILY PLANNING AWARENESS CAMP :- The population of our country surpassed over 100 corers. This over population eats into all the development process. Lack of resources Food job health care facilities, school and thousands of problems owe their origins to this over population. The awareness about the benefits of having a very small family is still very low in our country particularly in the areas of the eastern Uttar Pradesh where the population density is disproportionately high. Considering very high level of reluctance on part of the villagers to adopt the family planning methods the population explosion has taken place-causing deterioration in the family available sources like food, education, Housing, Employment opportunities etc. a programmes was organised by the NGO about the growth in the population. At the end of the programme condoms and contraceptive pills were distributed among the villages.

12. PULSE POLIO AWARENESS PROGRAMME:- Despite of so many claims made by the government authorities it is true that has been possible to eradicate polio from the society. Considering the responsibility the society organized a programme on Pulse Polio and vaccination to eradicate the disease from the society.

13. ROAD SAFETY PROGAMME :- The member of society organized a programme on Road Safety. The main aim of this programme was to aware the public by the rules of the Roads and the benefits of these Rules. The public appreciated this programme very much.

14. WELFARE PROGRAMME FOR STREET PERSONS:- The member of the society organized Welfare programme for street person on human right day. Medicines, cloths and many other things were distributed among street children free of cost.

15. ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAMME:-The society organized a programme on World Environment Day to discuss the impact of growing population on the human health and environment. The eminent speakers discussed the factors leading to increase in all types of pollution including water air and sound pollution. It was felt that there is need to speeded the process of removing old vehicles, reduces the use of plastics, compulsory use the effluent treatment plant by the controlling the pollution. On the same day the society organised a programme comprising of a painting contest and a participants of different areas. At the end of the programmes prizes were distributed among the winners of the contest.

16. A.G.P (AWARENESS GENERATION PROGRAMME):- It is understood true that still in our country 70% population lives in villages and due to certain constraints. Awareness by the person residing in rural areas are not so up to date as the person residing the urban areas. Keeping in mind the above problems this awareness generation programmes were organized by the society at NGO's premises. The basic aim of this programme was to make the people aware about the various type of new schemes launched by the government for welfare of public either it is in educational, employment or technical guidance.

17. HORTICULTURAL & FOOD PROCESSING TRAINING PROGRAMME:- Considering the availability of raw materials in plenty the society organized a programme on scope in the food processing industry. The programme was attended by many youth some of these youth have started their own food processing units and are earning their livelihood. In this programme the member of the society has told about new techniques of horticulture and advantage of these techniques.

18. MUSHROOM CULTIVATION & DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME :- Mushroom cultivation is more popular in present atmosphere end our society is requiring maximum use of mushroom so farmers were informed to go for mushroom cultivation, this will add the income of the farmers, which will increase their income & comforts in life.

19. MINI DAIRY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME :- In cities is a lack of milk, so to solve the problem of the citizens the society has told the unemployed youth to open a mini dairy to store the milk for the people in the cities according to their consumption.

20. SCREEN PRINTING TRAINING PROGRAMME :- Screen-printing training programme is also running under the guidance of the society. The main aim of this programme is to solve the problem of unemployment.

21. SELF HELP GROUP AWARENESS PROGRAMME :- Society organized a meeting self-help group. The aim of this meeting was to tell the responsibilities to the members of the group and how can they become able to integrated the people of the society and were always ready to solve the problems. The members appreciated this programme very much. Therefore, the meeting was terminated with vote of thanks to chair.
