ORGANISATION:

Jharkhand Samudayik Utthan Parishad (JSUP) is a Non-profit making Organisation registered under Societies Registration Act 21/1860 by the Govt. of Jharkhand, Ranchi. It's registered H.O. is situated in two storied building (Main town) at Town Thana Road, P.O+District-Dumka (Jharkhand). The total carpet area of the organization is about 1500 Sqrft. having different sizes 08 rooms along with training centre. Basically, it has been working for education and vocational training since its' inception. It has been working in Dumka district of Jharkhand since 2002. It has been striving for the betterment of the most deprived and marginalized section of the society so that no one remains hungry, unemployed, uneducated and exploited as its target group since inception. Its journey is 20 years old.

Organisational Information:

Brief Background of the Organisation:

"Jharkhand Samudayik Uthhan Parishad" is outcome of the association of young and committed youth inspired by Mahatma Gandhi. The group informally involved with society and found that condition of Rural and Urban Dalit, Minorities, Deprived Section like Farrmers, Unemployed youth, illiterate demos, labours and destitute women & children, is very poor and treated as most neglected community of the society. Taking this situation into account the group of people started working with this community in the year 2002 but with the intention to institutionalize the effort in 2004 the association finally got registered under able leadership of Social Activist Syed Akbar Jaan Zaidi along with established vision "To bring these section (Mentioned above) into the main stream of the society through promoting people center approach of development." Thus, "Contacting women, children, farmers, labours and youths, organization building, awareness and developing their skills" has become the mission of JSUP.

Organisation Primary area of focus:

The organization through its programmes and activities towards creating awareness, building organization in order to enhance collective bargaining power, developing their skill, education and health of women and children to increase the quality of life these deprived section.

The Vision and Mission:

The mission is to empower rural and urban the poor through social cohesiveness and livelihood creation. JSUP gives special emphasis on socio economic empowerment of most deprived section

including neglected poor downtrodden and other communities & to educate children (Male & Female both) of these section (deprived section) at least of primary level.

HISTORY: Jhakhand Samudayik Utthan Parishad (JSUP) was formed in 2002 by a group of social activists getting inspired by great freedom fighters and social educators like Mahatma Gandhi, Acharya Vinoba Bhave and Loknayak Jaiprakash Naryan. It works in Dumka district of Jharkhand. The Vision of Jharkhand Samudayik Utthan Parishad (JSUP) is to establish a people led society where no one remains hungry, unemployed, uneducated and exploited and the mission is to empower poor people through social cohesiveness and livelihood creation with special emphasis on socio-economic empowerment of Rural and Urban Dalit, Minorities, Deprived Section like Farmers, unemployed youth, illiterate demos, labours and destitute women & children. We have a good infrastructure and competent human resources.

The main key function of the NGO is to upgrade the social, economical, moral, and educational status of educated and literate people of the society basically it's surrounding district such as Godda, Jamtara, Deoghar, Pakur, Sahebganj. It has been imparting primary level education and different types of vocational training such as (Computer, Tailoring, Beautician, Hand Embroidery, English-Hindi Type-Shorthand, Soft Toys making etc.) Every year more than 100 candidates take different types of Vocational Training and most of them get jobs in Public and Private sector along with establish their own self employment.

Every year, many Govt. Department give different types of work. The NGO has worked in 19 Govt. Departments since it's' inception.
